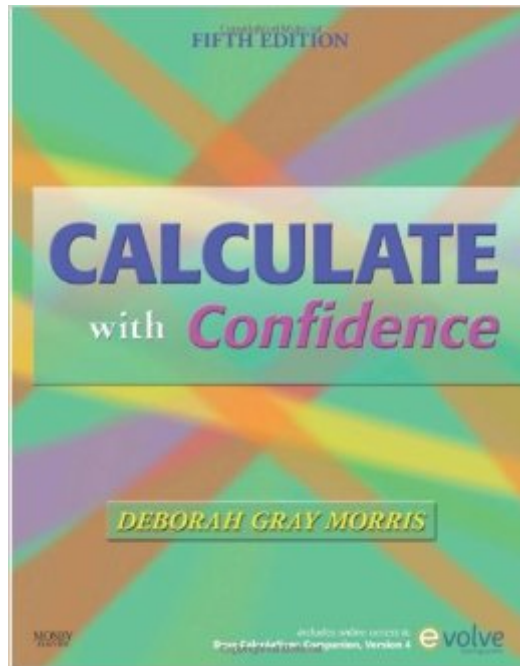


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# Calculate With Confidence, 5e (Morris, Calculate With Confidence)

What I like is that the book shows different ways of calculating medication doses such as ration and proportion, dimensional analysis and formula method. It also has questions on how to read physician orders. I would say half of this book was useful to me because I did practice answering some of the questions.
